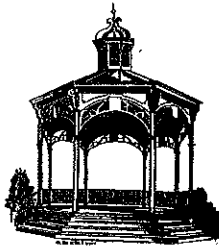

RE: Truck Route Ordinance

The City Council has discussed a possible truck route to keep large trucks passing through the city from going through the downtown. The truck route could not be accomplished last year because of the streetscape project. This year the implementation of the ordinance has been delayed by the necessary detour for the Silver Lake Road Bridge Project. Now that the bridge is substantially complete and the road is open for traffic the City Council has the opportunity to implement a truck route. The Chief of Police, DPW Director and the City Attorney have been working together to prepare the ordinance. We are now ready to present the ordinance to the City Council Work Session for the City Council to discuss the issue and begin the process for the adoption of the ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 32 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FENTON.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF FENTON DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: AMENDMENTS TO CODE: Section 32-58 of the Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 32-58. – Restrictions on size and weight.

Subject to certain exceptions set forth in this article, no person shall operate or haul or cause to be operated or hauled any vehicle, truck, truck tractor, trailer, or semi-trailer which exceeds the size or weight limitations or unit combination restrictions designated in this article.

Notwithstanding any other Section of this Code of Ordinances, except for Section 32-65, trucks or semi-trailers shall only be operated on the following streets:

- (a) Main Street/ Silver Lake Road between the eastern boundary of the city and the intersection of Main Street/ Silver Lake Road with the access ramps for US-23.
- (b) Fenway Drive between Owen Road and Silver Lake Road.
- (c) Owen Road between the intersection of Owen Road with the access ramps for US-23 and the intersection of Owen Road with Fenway Drive.
- (d) Leroy Street between the intersection of Leroy Street with Silver Lake Road/Main Street on the south and the northern boundary of the city.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY: The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any part is declared invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction it shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with Section 32-58 as amended are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days after its adoption and shall be published within 15 days of its adoption by publication of a brief notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, stating the date of enactment and the effective date of the ordinance, a brief statement as to the subject matter of this ordinance, and such other facts as the Clerk shall deem pertinent, and that a copy of the ordinance is available for public use and inspection at the office of the Clerk.
