WHEREAS, the City has adopted code provisions ("City of Fenton Code") establishing
the procedures and standards for the review of applications, transfers and renewals, and revocation

of licenses to sell alcohol within the City; and

WHEREAS, City of Fenton Code Sections 3-9, 3-13, and 3-15 provide that the City Council shall establish by resolution a fee for application of new liquor licenses, renewal of liquor licenses, and transfer of liquor licenses within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to update its liquor license fee schedule based upon fees that are reasonable and based upon the cost of administering Article II, Liquor, of Chapter 3 of the City of Fenton Code.

Sculpture Security Camera

On October 5, 2017, the City of Fenton is going to reveal a sculpture which will be located on the front lawn of the Fenton Community Center.

This sculpture is a special piece of artwork, and the security of the Fenton Community Center was the topic of a recent discussion. After several meetings, it was decided that a wireless camera capable of transmitting a high-quality video feed back to the Fenton Police Department, for inclusion in the existing server system, would be the best path to take.

The means to accomplish this goal is through the use of a 12MP 360° fisheye camera & wireless antenna kit to be mounted on a nearby light pole. The video transmission would then be sent wirelessly back to the police department where it would be stored on the police department's current video server. It would also allow for monitoring by dispatch personnel who are present in the police department 24 hours a day and 365 days a year.

The quote obtained for the cost of hardware and installation of this system is \$4923.00. Absolute Security & Investigations provided the attached quote and was the company that recently installed the Gazebo and Mill Pond Park cameras. I have confidence in the quality and workmanship they provide and recommend that we utilize Absolute Sales for this project if approved.

RE: Statue Camera Addition

Dear Chief Slater:

Absolute Security & Investigations is pleased to provide the Fenton Police Department with the following cost narrative for the addition of camera coverage for the new city statue.

As discussed, we will be deploying the 12MP 360° fisheye camera & wireless antenna kit on the light pole that has constant 120VAC power.

Per our discussion & site visit, the scope of work for this project will be as follows:

- Provide & install one (1) Avigilon 12.0MP 360° Fisheye day/night dome camera & pole mount
- Provide & install two (2) Avigilon PoE Plus power injector
- Provide & install one (1) Ubiquiti wireless bridge access point & mounting accessories
- Provide & install one (1) hardend PoE 5 port network switch for connection of the camera & antenna
- Provide & install one (1) NEMA heated enclosure with pole mount at power at bottom of pole
- Provide & install one (1) black paint for the NEMA enclosure, pole mounts, flat stock.
- Provide & install required cable, supports, & installation consumable's
- Adjust camera views with customer

This estimate is based on the following exclusions and assumptions:

- Owner to provide 120 VAC power @ the base of the light poles that will be inside our enclosure
- Owner to provide LAN/WAN connection for NVR distribution to any camera location
- Owner to provide network switch port in city hall within 100 meters of camera locations
- Owners existing computer network has availability for necessary static IP addresses and increased bandwidth activity. Problems or issues related to the network that delay the project will not be the responsibility of the contractor
- Owner to provide adequate video card for streaming video on any LAN/WAN computer
- Absolute Security not responsible for any connection, installation or programming at remote location(s)
- This proposal is designed for the use of 3-8 mega pixel cameras to maintain server continuity
- Day and night time picture quality for all cameras is subject to available and current ambient light in the viewing areas
- The cost for any permits if required, are not inclusive of this proposal and will be bill as additional
- Any changes to the scope with may be required by the local fire marshal and/or other AHJ are not inclusive of this proposal and will be bill as additional

- Work to be performed during normal business hours & no hindrances in gaining access to any of the necessary facilities, with prior planning and approval by client
- Owner to provide suitable staging area for equipment storage during project
- This proposal, bill of materials, pricing, assumptions, and maintenance summary are valid for ninety (90) days of this date.

Per the listed scope of work, bill of materials, assumptions and maintenance summary, budgetary estimates for this project will be \$4,923.00.

To add the second camera to the sidewalk pole, cost for the project would be \$8,404.00.
