## IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION TO CITY OF FENTON WATER CUSTOMERS DURING COVID-19 STAY AT HOME ORDER

May 8, 2020

Dear Fenton Water Customer,

As COVID-19 restrictions are reduced and/or lifted in the upcoming weeks and months, any commercial, industrial or residential property that has been unoccupied or experienced significantly less water usage may have aged water in the plumbing system where **flushing is strongly recommended**.

If water is not used for a long period of time it may become stagnant in the internal plumbing system which creates the potential for growth of bacteria in the water. Stagnant water in the internal plumbing system can also lead to water quality concerns that may pose a public health risk.

The City of Fenton Water Department strongly recommends **proper flushing procedures** for any water customer property where the plumbing has not been used for an extended period. The attached documents from the CDC and EGLE provide step-by-step instruction to assist the water customer perform proper water flushing procedures.

In addition, the City of Fenton Water Department is available during business hours if you require assistance to flush your water system. **This service is available at no cost** to the water customer during normal business hours.
